This 3,300 acre private estate subdivision is adjacent to the Timberline Ski Resort.

This is the first time since at least the 1970’s that Bald Eagles have called Canaan Valley their home. There is a 300 acre open and wooded conservation area that encircles the two lakes where the Eagles are nesting. The Eagles can be viewed in this area; soaring through the skies and swooping down for fish and small animals needed to feed their young.

Vacationers staying at vacation homes fronting the conservatory have been treated from time to time to Bald Eagles flying right past their decks. This is truly a magnificent sight for all of those people lucky enough to see this symbol of strength and beauty in the wild.



The Canaan Valley/Davis area of West Virginia has long been admired for its unique natural beauty, is home to two downhill and three cross-country ski areas; two state parks; the Canaan Valley National Wildlife Refuge; ‘cool-clear’ mountain streams; the Dolly Sods Wilderness Area and the Monongahela National Forest.
